What is the NHRA Open Series

The 2009 / 2010 season will consist of (3) single day events at Nashua Athletic Club in Nashua, NH and (3) single day events at Metro South Athletic Club in Brockton, MA. Each single day tournament is limited to 40 players and uses the Olympic format to allow players a minimum of 3 matches of play. Matches are 2 games to 11, win by 2 with a 3rd game as a tie breaker if necessary. Winning players in each of 3 drop down divisions are awarded cash prizes at the end of the day event. Players are awarded points based on where they finish. After the final (6) single day events are played the player earning the most points is the Open Series champion and earns an additional cash prize.

These events allow players an opportunity to play against the top ranked racquetball players in New England while allowing all players to have a full day of competitive racquetball. The events are held at the top racquetball clubs in New England, include food for the day and are sanctioned by the United States Racquetball Association, the governing board of competitive racquetball in the United States. Sanctioning provides player insurance, a national ranking system as well as online access to registration and results.

NHRA Open Series History

The 2008 / 2009 season was the inaugural year for the NHRA Open Series and we exceeded all of our expectations with the number of players, sponsors, fans and clubs that got involved in the events. The event was able to successfully draw players in the New England area that are highly ranked in the USAR National Rankings. Below is a list of highly ranked players who played last season and have been invited to return this season.
